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

Night time economy overview




Parts of Downtown, Back Bay, South Boston Waterfront and the airport are active through the night.


10% of trips in the city happen after 9 pm and before 5 am



#### Trips starting from 9 pm to 1 am




#### Trips starting from 1 am to 5 am










#### Suffolk County has a relatively high share of night shift workers compared to other peer cities and the national level

#### Night shift workers share over total workers



#### Night shift worker share by supersectors in Suffolk County














#### Night shift worker share in Leisure and Hospitality and Other Services









#### Share of Restaurants and Bars Licensed to Stay Open until Midnight or Later













At least 437 restaurants and bars actually stay open until midnight or later














### 16.1% of Suffolk County workers in transportation work the night shift

#### Night shift worker share in Transportation






#### MBTA ridership declines sharply after 5pm, but continues until closing





# MBTA passengers need to wait longer in night than daytime













#### Night shift workers are more likely to be female and aged 20-24 compared to day shift workers.















#### Occupations by night shift and day shift






