

Trends in School Enrollment & Educational Attainment 1990-2000


- The number of school aged children 5-17 increased from 73,684 or 12.8% of the population in 1990 to 84,513 or 14.3% in 2000.
- The number of pre-teens and teens (10-19) grew by 8,088 from 68,096 in 1990 to 76,184 in 2000. Today, in 2002, those youth would be aged 12-21 and represent a large pool of teen-agers and other young people who may be vulnerable to high risk activities.
- The number of children three years and over enrolled in school jumped dramatically by 11% or 18,876 more children:
 - Pre-primary school students (nursery & kindergarten) increased the most by 8,565 a 138% increase over 1990.
 - Students enrolled in grades 1 to 12 increased by 12% or 9,295 more students.
 (The number of students in the Boston Public Schools has grown from nearly 60,000 in 1990 to almost 63,000 in 2001.)
- The educational levels of Boston's population 25 years old and over continued to climb:
 - The percentage of persons with a high school diploma or higher increased from 75.7% in 1990 to 78.9% in 2000.
 - The percentage with some college or higher grew from 49.1% to 54.9%.
 - The percentage of persons with a bachelor's degree or higher increased from 30% in 1990 to 35.5% in 2000, and the growth of those with degrees beyond the bachelor's level outpaced the growth of those with bachelor's degrees 28% to 19%.




