

Trends in Racial Composition and Age:

- Boston's population grew by a modest 2.6% during the decade. Underneath this growth are various trends in population and diversity in the city's neighborhoods.
- Racial composition reflects an increasing level of diversity marked by the following trends:
 - Non-whites including Latinos now form the majority.
 - Latino and Asian residents are the fastest growing minority residents.
 - A substantial percentage of residents identify themselves as multiracial or "other racial groups".
 - The composition of major age groups shows a significant decline in the elderly while there has been a marked increase in the 5 -17 year olds.




